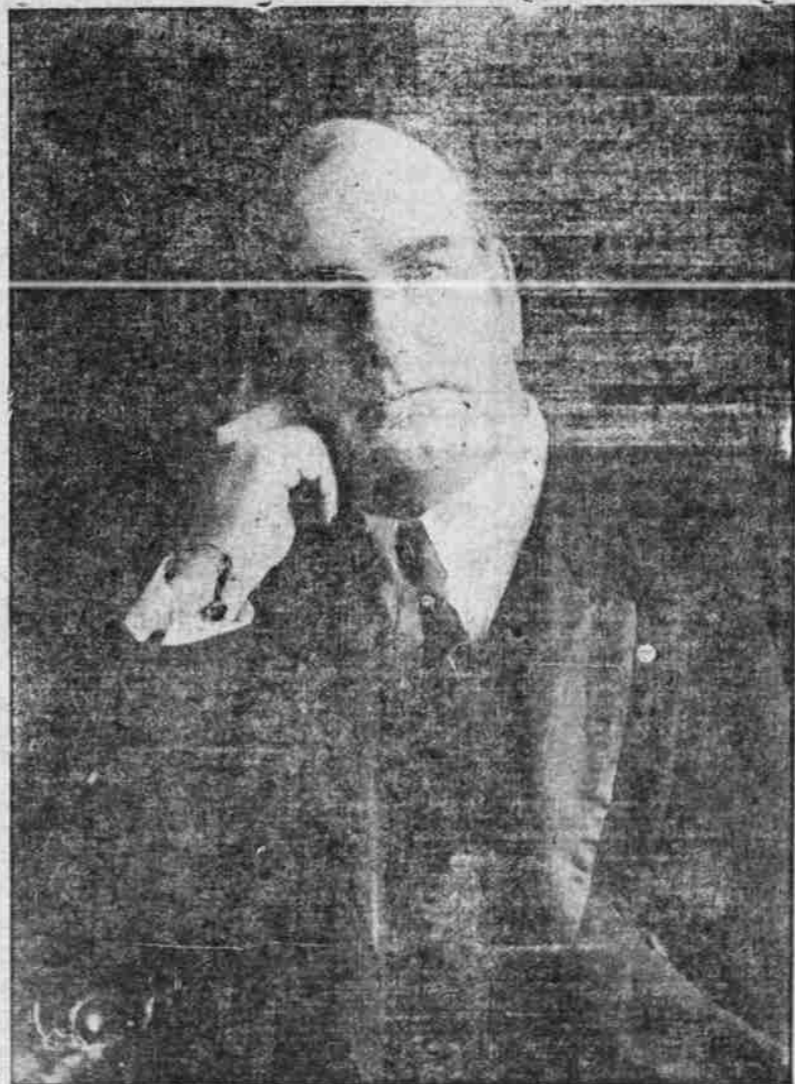
HOUSE OF BONDAGE WILL BE SEEN FRIDAY NIGHT
