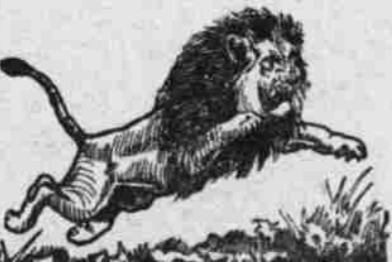

All such accounts will be handled through the central agency. There are now 56 members of the association, six joining within the last week.

PLANT BEETS WITH HASTE

An item that has especial significance this spring, is that seeding of sugar beets has commenced. But for the proper application of influence at the right time, there would have been no sugar factory, consequently no need of planting beets this year. The seeding started yesterday. The Hall ranch near Union and several of the smaller farms in that district, are being prepared and planted this week. The La Grande district will also be seeded just as rapidly as the workmen can do so. The beet acreage will be a trifle below that of former years due to the fact that some of the land is in need of irrigation and can not profitably be used for beets again until water is applied.

SHOWED SOME SPEED.

Because they were married before the time designed by law between the date of divorce and the date of remarriage had elapsed, Edward and Babie Begg, were married for the second time within three months, this afternoon, says the Pendleton East Oregonian. Justice of the Peace Joe H. Parkes officiated at this ceremony. Horsh is a resident of Walla Walla county, Washington, and the bride is supposed to be a resident of Umatilla county. The couple were married about three months ago, presumably in Walla Walla, but as one of them had been granted a divorce less than six months before it became necessary to have the knot retied.
