La Grande is certainly rightly designated as the city of payrolls. On the 10th, the Grand Ronde Lumber Company and the Geo Palmer Mills of this city distributed no less than \$35,000. Friday of this week the \$30,000 or more O. R. & N. pay checks will be here and this week Receiver Nelder is disbursing about \$100,000 making a total of no less than \$100,000 that is being disbursed in this city in one week. This with the natural opening of spring activity will aid business in all lines.

When it requires thirteen weeks to secure a jury, as has been demonstrated at San Francisco in the Calhoun graft case, naturally public opinion revolts at the justice or rather the injustice to which technicalities of law during trials creep in, when there is ample money to keep the machinery well oiled.
