WALLA WALLA PLEASED

The Walla Bulletin of Friday says: "Interest in the carnival is on the increase, and the fourth day of Walla Walla's big fun festival, under the auspices of the County Fair Association, proved to be the most successful in point of attendance and the amount of good natured enthusiasm displayed. The festivities of the evening were ushered in to the merry strains of "The Broadway Belles," and an accompaniment of shouting spliers, without which no carnival would seem quite complete.
 "The Parker shows are offering this year one of their chief features, the big three-ring animal circus owned and operated by Colonel Al G. Barnes, the veteran showman and animal master.
 "The feature act presented by Mme. Mille Barnes, during the course of which she introduces an immense lion riding on the back of a galloping horse, is one of the most remarkable ever seen here, and it is all the more noteworthy when it is recalled that the lion and the horse are deadly enemies.
 "The ponies, bears, dogs, elephants, monkeys and goats contribute to a performance that for merit, magnitude and comprehensiveness has never

been equaled in Walla Walla.
 "Judging by the immense crowds that bank up in front of the imposing entrance to the "Broadway Belles" pavilion that attraction drew the largest crowd, and all who emerged from the cozy canvas theatre were loud in their manifestations of approval.
 "One of the attractions fostered by the Parker show deserving of extended mention is "Pharaoh's Daughter," a mystifying illusion combined with Oriental stage settings, spectacular dancing of an ultra-refined kind, beautiful poses plastique and pictorial song poems."

ELEPHANT'S FOOT FOR ROOSEVELT.

LONDON, April 27.—While Colonel Roosevelt is in Africa he will have an opportunity of tasting that delicious dish, baked elephant's foot. The Elephas Indicus or Elephas (London) Africanus walks on his toes and the balls of his feet. The real foot of an elephant extends up some distance from the ground. Like the "trotter" of the hog, the foot of the elephant is full of gluten, and the flesh, if properly baked, is very tender, tasting something between pork and chicken. From a freshly killed elephant the foot is cut off at the ankle, and baked in a hole in the ground which has previously been heated with hot stones. The hole must be red hot and a few heavy stones left in the bottom. The foot having been put into the hole, which is made just about big enough to receive it—some natives line the hole with green leaves—sand is shoveled over it and left to cook. One must not be in a hurry for his dinner. When taken out and the thick skin peeled away a delicious morsel awaits the epicure.


KING ARTHUR KNIGHTS MEET AT NEWARK

NEWARK, N. J. April 27.—Seventeen eastern New Jersey "castles" of the Knights of King Arthur, an organization of boys, are represented at a grand conclave of the order today in the Y. M. C. A. buildings.
 Nearly 1700 castles have been formed throughout the United States. The 17 attending the conclave are located in Newark, Montclair, Verona, East Orange, Paterson, Elizabeth, Jersey City, Hoboken and Weehawken. About 200 boys are expected to be on hand.
