FRAWLEY'S BONDSMAN MAKE SETTLEMENT

The county court has made a satisfactory settlement with the bondsmen of County Treasurer John Frawley, to cover the loss sustained by the failure of the Farmers & Traders National Bank. At the time the doors closed the treasurer had about \$21,000 on deposit. The dividend of 45 per cent reduced the amount to about \$11,000 and when the county court made the demand on the bondsmen for the remainder, they waived all rights for litigation and agreed to reimburse the county by paying \$20,000 in cash and remainder in installments within the year. After due consideration the court accepted the offer, so all the county will be out will be the interest, which will amount to less than \$300. Taking everything into consideration this is certainly a very satisfactory conclusion of a very unfortunate affair.

Had the bank failed either a few days before it did or a few days later the amount of county funds in the institution would not have exceeded a few thousand dollars. Mr. Frawley had made a policy of depositing the county money in the several banks of the county but used the Farmers & Traders Bank for his checking account. He was drawing from the other banks to pay out \$18,000 of

school money, and this was the reason for the large amount in the bank at the time of the failure.

No county in the state has ever had a more painstaking or careful treasurer and no one blames him, not even his bondsmen, who during all of this time have never asked to be relieved, knowing that the loss was through no fault of his.

which no one regretted more than Mr. Frawley. For the sixth term Treasurer Frawley has been serving the county in his present capacity. For the first six years of this period he received for his services \$58 per month, then the salary was increased to \$83 per month where it remained until one year ago when the legislature made the remuneration \$1200 per annum. The entire remuneration Mr. Frawley has received during the 11 years he has been in office would not equal his loss. During all this time he has done all the work connected with the office and not one dollar's worth of extra clerical hire has ever been charged to the county.

Another unfortunate incident was the fact that when the famous auto race was being made from La Grande to Elgin, Mr. Frawley made a deposit of \$8000.
