What is apparently the most authentic information procurable about the new train service through La Grande is related in the Portland Journal of yesterday. It seems the train starts next Sunday according to this:
Portland officials of the Harriman lines were wired from Chicago this morning to the effect that the new train service between Portland and Chicago over the O. R. & N., including the installation of a limited electric lighted train to carry first class passengers, must go into effect on next Sunday.

The receipt of the telegram from Chicago was unexpected, and while Harriman officials have known for some time that the change was brewing, it was not supposed it would take place as early as Sunday.

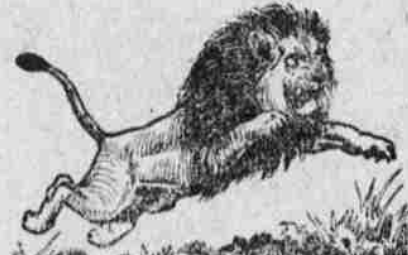
Taylor Leaves Tomorrow.
