There is a reward of \$500 offered by the state of Oregon, also \$500 by the Sheep Association and \$250 by Mr. Huffman for the arrest and conviction of the parties who destroyed his buildings, and a good bit at the state pen in store for the guilty parties when apprehended.

CITY SCALES POPULAR

Although the ordinance providing for official weighing of all hay, grain, coal, etc., sold within the city limits does not go into effect until the 25th Inst., Recorder Cox has taken in a total of 50 cents in fees since the scales were instead. On the 14th J. W. Minnick weighed a load of scrap iron which he had sold to Fitzgerald, and the same day Ed Halley had weighed a load of wool which was consigned to Mac Wood of the Golden Rule Co. TEST TRAIN TAKEN OUT

General Superintendent M. J. Buckley, Superintendent D. W. Campbell, Assistant Chief Engineer W. B. Bolins, Chief of Motive Power, Graham, and Master Mechanic, J. T. Langley, all O. R. & N. officials, this forenoon

took a freight train of capacity tonnage—1500 tons, up the Kamela hill on an air brake test run that is as near perfect as it is possible to make a train this far from the factory shops. The equipment was new, so new that the paint was not scratched, and when the stenographers and clerks who are with the officials, transcribe their notes, the O. R. & N. motive department will have a report ready on the efficiency of air brakes that cannot be bettered any where on the O. R. & N. system for the test was made on the highest per cent grade on the road.

It is always planned on such occasions to take out a capacity load. Furthermore the largest hill available is used in the test that full benefit may be derived from the efforts. A month ago there was a full train of new cars, loaded to capacity, but Mr. Buckley could not come at that time, and the train was gradually knocked
