Ordinance No. 424, Series 1909.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to enter into a contract with Chas. Taal, for grading a portion of L avenue and grading and filling the City Hall block.

THE CITY OF LA GRANDE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1—That the Mayor and Recorder be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chas. Taal, for the grading of a portion of L Avenue, and the grading and filling of the City Hall block, at a price not more than \$800.

Section 2—Inasmuch as the contractor Charles Taal has proceeded with the work described in Section 1 hereof, and will soon have the same completed, now therefore, in order to preserve the comfort, and well being of the citizens of the community, and to protect the credit of the city, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in force and take effect on and after its approval by the Mayor.

Passed the Common Council on the 19th day of May, 1909, by seven members voting therefor.
