BODY FOUND LAST NIGHT

Word came to La Grande late yesterday afternoon that the body of Berne De Lappe, one of the little boys drowned at Island City nearly four weeks ago had been found several miles below the town, floating in an eddy amongst debris carried down by the recent high water. Justice Stewart was deputized as Coroner by Dr. Bacon, and with Undertaker J. J. Carr returned with the body about 7:30.

The funeral was conducted at Island City at 11 o'clock this forenoon by Rev. C. E. Deal. Immediately after the funeral the burial party proceeded to Summerville where interment was made.

Not Badly Decomposed.
The little body was not badly decomposed until several hours after being removed from the water, although the face was much swollen. No trace has yet been found of the body of Marion Delaney, drowned at the same time.
