STUMP LAND IN DEMAND

Stump land in the vicinity of Elgin is rapidly being sold for fruit land purposes. Lee Bell, the Elgin real estate dealer, was in the city last evening closing up a contract with P. E. Terpaney, a brother of the night operator at the Western Union office, who is staying here, for the purchase by him of 80 acres of stump land near Elgin. A stream runs through the land, and a house graces the tract. It cost the buyer \$10 an acre and when cleaned off stumps is splendidly suited for fruit land. The sub-irrigation is perfect in that section and no difference how dry the climate there is always moisture near the surface.

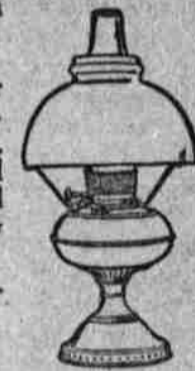
