FIVE NAMES SUGGESTED

Five suitable names have been sent the Observer for the two new steamboats to run between San Francisco and Portland, for which the Portland and San Francisco Steamship Company have offered a prize of \$50, for the one most suitable.

Mrs. Walter F. Gibbons of La Grande suggested that one be called Exposition in honor of the exposition to be held in Oregon this year, and the other the Dauntless, as San Francisco has proven herself so in rebuilding the ruined city. "La Grande" and "Pendleton" were suggested by J. R. Price of this city. He gives as his reason for doing so is that the steamship company secures a great amount of traffic from this part of the state and that La Grande and Pendleton, being the chief shipping points, should receive the honors. Mrs. Lorenza Stillwell of this city thinks that Captain Grey, who it is said, was the first man to enter Oregon, and "Lewis and Clark" Victor Hansen, of Telocaset, thinks that the names of "Ros-e-gon" and "Cal-ore" are very appropriate. Louis Reeves of Baker City has suggested that the ships be named "Port Franc" and "Ore-callif" in honor of the two states and the principal city of each. The names will be forwarded to the steamship company by the Observer in due time.
