BOOTLEGGER RELEASED

A man who gave his name as O. Jacobs and his home as Lostine was arrested by Officer Black last evening about dark charged with bootlegging. Jacobs arrived from Baker yesterday morning and took room at the Blue Mountain hotel. The landlady of the house noticed that he acted very queerly and reported him to the officers. Black watched him until late, and though he noticed the man's queer actions, he saw no reason why he should make an arrest. In the afternoon a Mr. Hiatt reported to the officer that he had been drugged, and described Jacobs as the man who gave him the doped whiskey. The officer then went to the Blue Mountain house where he found Jacobs engaged in mixing several ingredients he was taken to the city jail and locked up. It has since developed that Chris Simpson and Dan Rogers were also drugged in the afternoon. Simpson states that he will testify that he was drugged but is not sure that the man Jacobs was the man who gave him dope. He says that he took two drinks of near beer with him and immediately afterwards felt the effect of the drug. Dan Rogers could not be found up to late hour this afternoon.

It is said by Hiatt that the fellow who gave him drugged booze went through his clothing in a search for valuables, but found none. He refuses to promise to testify against Jacobs, who when arrested last evening had with him two pint bottles, two half pints, and a quart of whiskey, besides some kind of drug in a Liqueur bottle.

This morning at an early hour Officer Black went to the man's room at the Blue Mountain House and secured his grip. It contained cooking utensils, a sack of chittim bark, a sack of lemons, some coffee and a bottle of carbolic acid.

Jacobs says that he came down from Baker City yesterday and brought the whiskey with him for his own use. He also says that he never sold nor gave away any whiskey yesterday and that he was weakening the stuff when arrested. He says that he took two drinks of his own whiskey yesterday in one of the joints on Jefferson avenue and that he never had a drink at any time with any of the men alleged to have been drugged.

After investigation of the evidence which they could obtain against Jacobs, and finding that it would not convict, the officers released him this afternoon. Jacobs says that he has lived in Wallowa county for 31 years, has been square and aboveboard in all his dealings, and has never before been in jail. He declares that the booze was only for his own use.
