**Chicago And The Text Book.**  
 Chicago has seriously and systematically taken up the question of cost in school text books, and seems ready to decide to issue its own text books in the form of leaflets. According to the telegrams received, the average cost per pupil for books each term is \$3; under the proposed leaflet system which the board itself will issue the cost would be \$1.25.  
 Every section of the country feels the heavy drain upon it for school books. It is not alone their first cost, which is entirely too great, but that so many books that are little used, some of them scarcely at all, must be bought to comply with the school regulations, and their cost is sufficiently great to be felt. We should not be surprised if the outcome would be something like that proposed in Chicago. Either that or the prices will be so reduced for the text books as to bring them within reasonable limits. Meantime it might not be a bad plan for the city superintendent to carefully investigate to discover if there are not a number of books enumerated in the official lists which are scarcely used at all, which might be eliminated, and thus save parents some of the weight of expenditure that falls heavily upon them with the increasing cost of living.—Portland Telegram.
