NOTED CAR CITY WILL BE DESERTED IN YARDS

One of the four best equipped cars from the standpoint of air brakes that has ever been built anywhere in the world, is in La Grande today in charge of airbrake experts sent out by the International Correspondence school at Scranton, and for the next two weeks will be held at La Grande for the benefit of local trainmen of all classes. There are three experts here who will deliver lectures and explain the finer points of air brake system to any who may apply at the door of the car. There is no detail or feature in testing, inspection and the like, that cannot be shown and explained by these men. The lectures commenced at 10:30 this morning and will continue each day while the car is here. The men in charge, are F. Keeler, superintendent; W. F. Dillan, instructor, and J. M. McClelland, engineer. All instruction in this connection is gratis and every local employe of the O. R. & N. who has to do with airbrakes, will visit the car and learn things which he has never heard of before. For the men in charge are experts, working with the finest equipment attainable.
