WATER PIPE COMES SOON

Superintendent Gilman, of the water department, expects the car load of pipe recently shipped from Seattle to arrive tonight or tomorrow. The need for it is urgent, and residents along Grandy avenue and North Second are anxiously awaiting the time when they may sprinkle their lawns. There have been several applications for mains filed, but have not yet been acted upon by the council, which has been awaiting for the arrival of the pipe.

The shipment consists of 5300 feet of 4 inch pipe, fittings for the same and four Corey hydrants. The cost of the lot is about \$1500. One thousand two hundred feet will be laid along Grandy avenue, and 800 feet on North Second.

MODEL IDLE ON SUNDAY
