### CHARTER IS DECLARED IN FULL FORCE

The necessary proclamation from Mayor M. K. Hall to make the recently-adopted charter effective, is issued today in the official notice in this issue. While the new book was nominally the guide for several days, it is not officially so until after publication of the notice mentioned. The proclamation, officially, follows:

**PROCLAMATION.**

Whereas, at a special election held in the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 22nd day of June, A. D. 1909, there was submitted to the legal voters thereof, a revised and consolidated charter of the City of La Grande, Union county, Oregon, providing by an act entitled: "An act to provide a revised and consolidated charter of the City of La Grande, on the 21st day of April, A. D. 1909, and ordained and submitted to the people of said City by the council thereof by Ordinance No. 418, Series 1909, entitled: 'An Ordinance ordaining a revised and consolidated charter of the City of La Grande, Oregon, and submitting the same to the legal voters of said city for adoption or rejection at a special election to be held therein, on June 22nd, A. D. 1909; And whereas, at said special election on said June 22nd A. D. 1909, there were cast 293 votes for said revised and consolidated charter, and 37 votes against said charter;

Now, therefore, I, M. K. Hall, Mayor of the City of La Grande, in Union County, State of Oregon, do hereby proclaim and declare said revised and consolidated charter adopted, and in full force and effect as the charter of the City of La Grande, from this date.

Done and dated at the City of La Grande, Oregon, this 25th day of June, A. D. 1909.
