Dairy cows are not for sale in Union county, especially the Grande Ronde valley. Mr. Clark of Butte, Montana, will attest to this statement. Having heard through newspapers of the Northwest, of the magnificent dairy stock maintained in this valley by the numerous herd owners, Mr. Clark came here to buy up all he could get a hold of. He traversed the county from one end to the other, but went

back disappointed; not a single owner of first-class dairy cows, wished to part company. It is too profitable a business, this owning valuable milk cows, to dispose of them to out of valley buyers. There are but few who are not looking for more blooded dairy cows, but on the other scarcely an exception to the rule that owners are refusing to dispose of this money-making adjunct to their farming.
