BRASEL LOOSES SUIT IN SUPREME COURT

Supreme Judge McBride, has handed down an opinion in the appealed suit of E. S. Brasel of this city against the O. R. & N., which upholds the findings of the circuit court jury J. W. Knowles, presiding here and affirms no errors existed in the trial's progress.

By this opinion, Brasel is refused any remuneration for injuries sus-

tained while working in the old round house here. He fell, he says, by reason of a defective hand rail on an engine and sustained very serious injuries. He lost his case in the circuit court, but appealed it. His attorneys were Lomax & Anderson, of Baker City, and for the O. R. & N., C. E. Cochran and C. J. Spencer an O. R. & N. counsel handled the case.

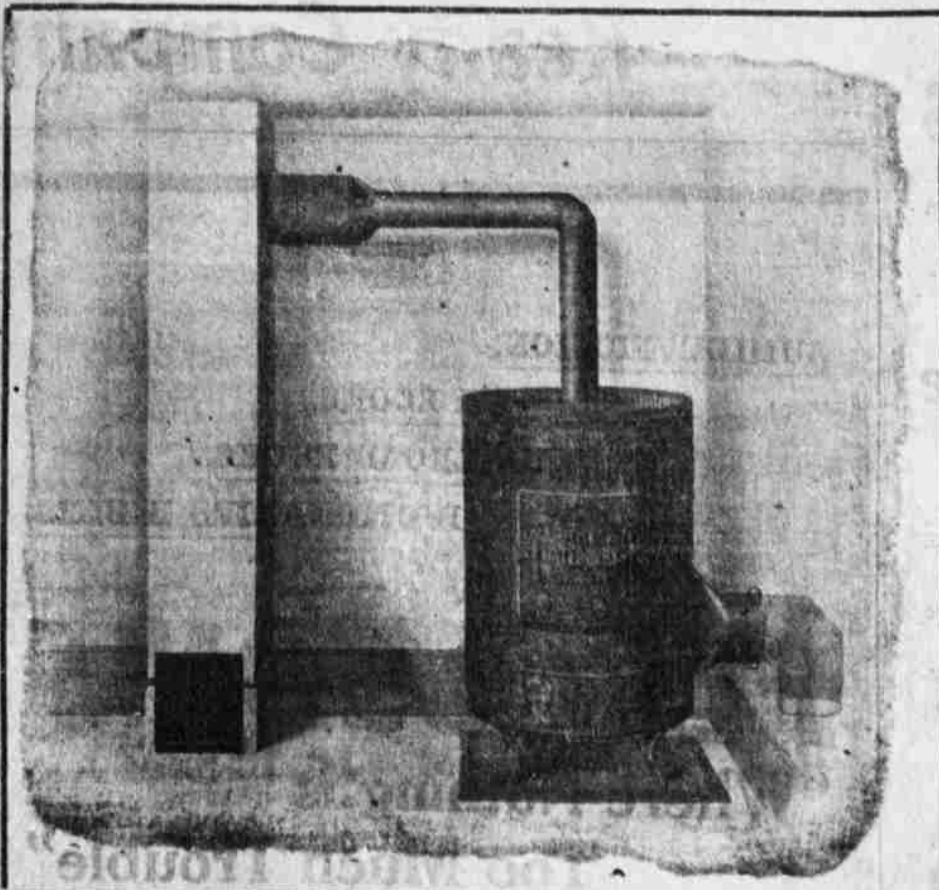
