APPLE FAIR IS ENLARGED

ALBANY APPLE SHOW EARLY IN NOVEMBER.

Wider Scope And Purposes For Big Apple Show.

ALBANY, Oregon, July 28.—(Special)—The scope of the Albany Annual Apple Fair will be enlarged this year to include apple growers in all sections of the Willamette valley. Fruit men will be invited to make displays in competition for a magnificent list of premiums.

An executive committee has been selected from the ranks of the Linn County Horticultural Society and the Albany Commercial club who will have charge of the details of the event, the date of which will be fixed for the early part of November. CHERRIES STAND RAIN

INCH PRECIPITATION FAILS TO HURT FRUIT.

Usual Bursting of Ripe Fruit Missing This Time.

Union county cherries withstood the rainfall of the past 36 hours splendidly, and notwithstanding that the precipitation was almost one inch, little damage was done. The chief danger lay in cherries ready for the pickers. Tendencies of ripe cherries are to burst open when rain falls too generously, but according to local fruit buyers, this condition does not exist today. Picking is delayed, but as fruit matures slowly under damp climatic conditions, there is but little danger of the crop suffering by over ripeness.

Ordinance No. 430, Series 1909.
An ordinance amending section 1 of Ordinance No. 425, Series 1909.
THE CITY OF LA GRANDE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 425, Series 1909, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. That all Opera houses, theaters, churches, School houses, public halls, lodge rooms, club rooms and all other buildings used for public gatherings; all office buildings, hotels, boarding houses and lodging houses, shall have at least one front on a public street, and shall have in front suitable means of entrance and exit; all outside doors in such buildings shall be not less than four feet wide, and shall open outwards; all doors at the head of stairways shall be of the same width as the stairways and shall open outwards. Exits shall be provided in such buildings on the second floor and on all floors higher up, leading to stairs, or ladders, built of iron or some other fire-proof material, which shall at all times be kept in good repair, and all exits kept free from obstruction, and in condition to furnish a safe descent to the ground for the inmates of such buildings. Over each of such exits there shall be on the inside the word, "EXIT" painted in large letters, not less than six inches high; in no case shall there be less than two such exits to each of such buildings, one of which exits shall be on one front, and one on a side of such building fronting on a street or alley. And in case any such building is of sufficient capacity to accommodate 100 persons, or more, there shall be in such buildings at least three such exits placed as above described, which shall be indicated by the word "EXIT" painted over the same, on the inside as above provided.

And it is hereby made the duty of the Chief of Police and the Chief of the Fire Department to see that the provisions of this Ordinance are strictly enforced.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the present regulations in regard to fire escapes are insufficient, now therefore, in order to secure the peace, health, safety and well being of the City and its inhabitants, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect, on the 25th day of July, 1909, after its approval by the Mayor, and the publication thereof in one issue of the La Grande Evening Observer.

Passed the Common Council on the 21st day of July, 1909, by six mem-

bers voting therefor.
Approved this 22nd day of July, A. D., 1909.

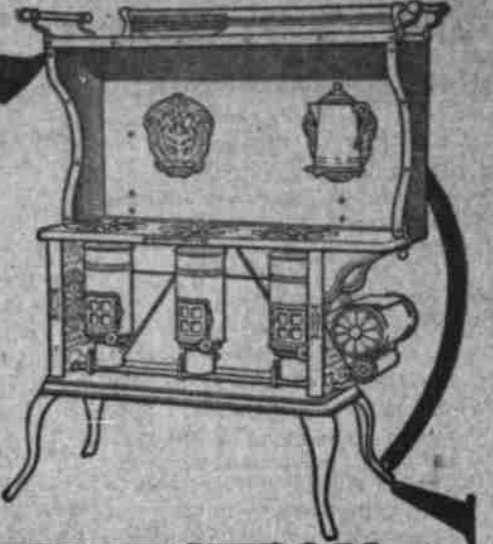
