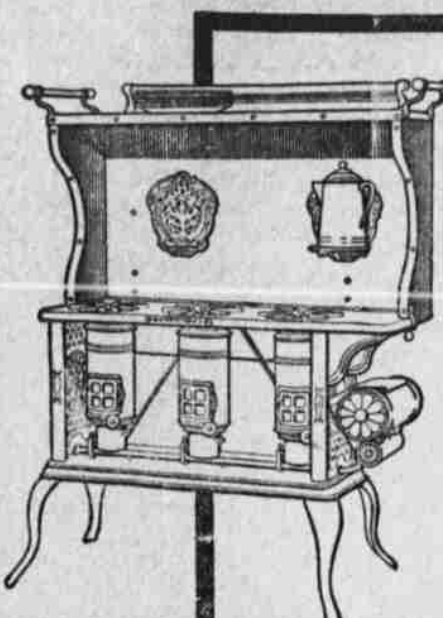
Be it further resolved that this resolution be published in one issue of the papers of the city.
