NEW POUND IS PURCHASED

J. M. SUTHERLAND NAMED AS POUNDMASTER.

Strict Enforcement of Stock Law is Ordered.

(From Union Progress.)

The City Council have purchased land from A. E. Eaton for an estray pound. This land is admirably situated as it has plenty of shade and runs right into Catherine creek so the stock that happens to get into this undesirable place will have plenty of water and shade. This is a step in the right direction as the pound that has been in use is too near the railroad to be easily accessible to stock that is "afraid of the cars."

Mr. J. M. Sutherland has been appointed by the City Council as Pound Master under the provisions of city stock ordinance No. 104, and will have charge of the impounding of all stock. We believe that Mr. Sutherland will not show any favoritism, so you had best keep your cow within an enclosure, or you are liable to have an interview with Mr. Sutherland. Under the provisions of this ordinance every one, whether an officer or not has the right to take up any stock running at large, or picketed or herded on the streets of the city and must turn them over to the Poundmaster, and he has exclusive jurisdiction as to their care and disposition.
