DELEGATE COMES BACK

Overwhelming popularity with the methods of Gifford Pinchot and dissatisfaction with the policies of Secretary of the Interior Ballinger, marks the Spokane irrigation congress according to Joint Representative Jerry Rusk of Joseph, who returned this morning from Spokane and went on to his home. He reported that much good was being derived from the congress, however, regardless of the fight.

Regarding politics in Wallowa county, the representative affirms that everything is quiet and that no bees are buzzing nor are there any lightning rods being run.

Rush Sumpter Road.

Determined to have the Sumpter Valley railroad extension completed so that trains can be run to Prairie City on Thanksgiving Day if possible. Manager Grant Geddes is bending every effort to keep the work pushed forward, says the Baker City Herald. He is adding men almost daily and

now three hundred are on the company's payroll.

Next month it is fully expected that the road will have reached the summit where a station will be established. Rails for the new road have been shipped and are now on the way to Baker City.

When seen this morning by a representative of the Herald, Mr. Geddes was well pleased with the progress being made. When asked if it would be possible for a delegation of business men from Baker to make the trip to Prairie City on Thanksgiving Day over the new railroad, he said: "I hope so. We will do our best to make such an event possible. Of course there are wheels within wheels in railroad building and no one can see into the future in a way that will outline every obstacle that is to be overcome. But we are getting along nicely with the work and it will not be many months until Prairie City will have a railroad."

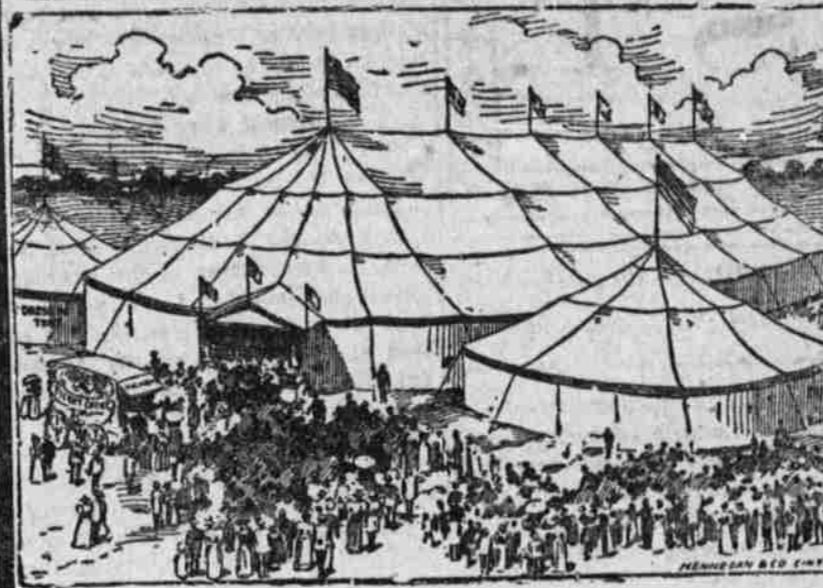
