#### Reading Notices.

#### Sixty-Eight New Doctors.

At a meeting of the Oregon Board of Medical Examiners held in Portland on the 21st, the names were given out of the applicants for licenses who were successful in passing the recent examinations of the board. From Dr. Moore who is one of the six doctors on the board, we learn that sixty-eight in all were licensed, making two-thirds of the entire number, who passed. One hundred M. D.'s, and twelve D. O.'s, took the examination with the result that fifty-eight medical doctors and ten osteopathic doctors succeeded in making the required average. All doctors who go before the board take the same examination in anatomy, physiology, histology, pathology, chemistry, obstetrics and gynecology. In addition to these subjects the medical applicants are examined in various branches of theory and practice of their school, while the osteopathic applicants are examined in practice of osteopathy.
