JAIL BREAK BOLD ONE

THE DALLES, Aug. 24.—Selecting a time when no one was in the sheriff's office except Jailer John Fitzgerald, two alleged criminals lodged in the county jail awaiting trial, George Robbins for the alleged murder of Emaline Castro of Hood River, and C. E. Wilson, accused of assault and larceny from a person, broke from The Dalles jail last evening about 7 o'clock.

Striking Jailer Fitzgerald down with an oak club, they secured a thirty-eight calibre six-shooter from a draw in the sheriff's desk and ran down Third street across Mill Creek and through the O. R. & N. repair yards to the rough country along the Columbia west of The Dalles.

As soon as the jailer regained his senses he telephoned for Deputy Sheriff Glenn Allen, who with a small posse of officers and men started in search. Sheriff Chrisman, upon learning of the episode, struck down the river in a launch. A third party, headed by Policeman John Crate, followed along the banks of the Columbia, and found Robbins near the Columbia end of the tunnel through the O. R. & N. peninsula. Wilson is still at large.

Reading Notices.
