This has been due to the fact that owing to water competition the railroad company has been forced to make a rate to Portland a cent and a half lower than from any other point in the county that does not have water competition. Now, however, Mr. Smith announces that the Open River company is in a positon to transport the wheat to Portland for a cent and a Weekly, six months in advance...
