"Holy matrimony "is an honorable estate instituted of God in the time of man's innocency;" and for those who profess and call themselver Chris tians, it further signifies "the mystical union betwixt Christ and his church, which holy estate Christ adorned and beautified with His presence and first miracle that he wrought in Cana of Galllee, and Is commended of Saint Paul to be hono able among all men, and therefore is not to be entered into unadvisedly or lightly, but reverently, discreetly, advisedly, soberly, and in the fear of God."
