For the best ten boxes of commercial apples, \$50 first, and \$25 second.

For the best commercial pack of apples, not less than ten boxes, first \$50 and second \$25.

For the best grade of draft team, first \$25 and second \$15.

For the best bushel of wheat grown on not less than ten acres, first \$10 and second \$5.

For the best Milch cow, not registered, first \$25 and second \$15.

For the best display of alfalfa, timothy and flowers, first \$10, and \$5 for each display.

For the best bushel of oats, first \$10 and second \$5.

For the best 100 pounds of commercial potatoes, first \$10 and second \$5.

For the best display of poultry, first \$10 and second \$5.

For the best five pack boxes of commercial pears, \$25.

For the best display of Shetland ponies, \$25.

For the best five fat hogs under one year old, first \$25 and second \$15.

## LA GRANDE ON ROUTE OF THE AUTO RELAY RACE

W. H. Kinston, Special Representative of the Philadelphia press, was in La Grande yesterday in the interests of the trans-continental relay automobile race to take place in September.

Mr. Kinston represents the press in the race and it is thought that they will break a world's record for long distances. The message to be carried by the racers is from the mayor of Philadelphia to Governor Hay of Washington. The messenger will remain in the car night and day and it is expected that they will reach Seattle after eight days from Philadelphia, making the trip on an average of 20 miles per hour. The message will leave Philadelphia

September 10, and will probably be in La Grande on the 16th or 17th. The message will be brought from Weiser to Baker City in a Buick owned by Mr. Lloyd and from Baker to La Grande it will be brought by Mr. Chandler in a White Steamer. When it reaches La Grande it will be met by an automobile from Walla Walla, where another car will pick it up and take it on to the next relay.

Mr. Kinston thinks that the time is coming when there will be a trans-continental auto road and that Baker City and La Grande will be on that route. He says that Eastern Oregon is worth going out of the way to see, but fortunately it is right on the best route from the east to the northern Pacific coast.
