RAPID PROGRESS ON PIPE LINE DITCH IS REPORTED

John Wilson this morning sent word to Superintendent Dutch from Rock Creek, where his crew is making roads for hauling supplies over to the ditch and pipe gang on the Beaver Creek project, that the work was progressing at an exceptionally rapid rate. Similar word was received a day or two ago from Messrs Dean and Lightner, who have the ditch and clearing gang at work on Beaver Creek. Mr. Wilson is working toward Beaver Creek, with headquarters at Rock Creek.

Men Very Scarce.

White men are hard to get, in fact Mr. Dutch is not having any success

finding them at all. Arrangement for importation of a small crew of Greeks and more Japs were made today, and they will be kept at work continually until the work is finished, unless enough white men apply for work. 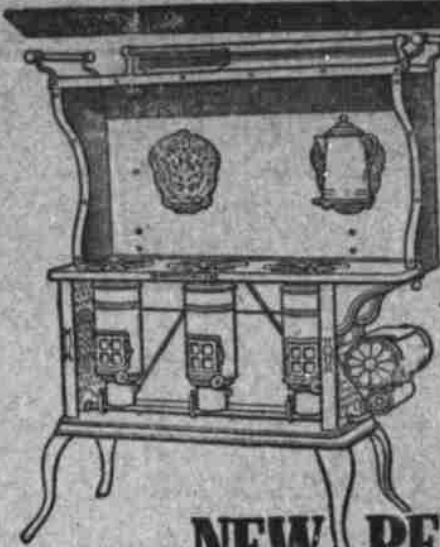
