'47 PIONEER HAS MEDAL

Samuel A. Whitney, a pioneer of Salt Lake since '47, who has been visiting relatives at Elgin and La Grande, left today for Seattle, where he will visit the fair. Sixty-two years ago when a boy of seven years, Mr. Whitney crossed the plains in a prairie schooner and his parents drew up their long march at Salt Lake and there Mr. Whitney has grown to mature age. He carries, with considerable pride, a medal of honor bestowed upon him by the state of Utah as a pioneer of '47, when that sturdy nucleus of the Mormon church landed at the briny lake. The emblem is embellished with appropriate symbols and bears the name of Mr. Whitney.

During his stay in Union county, Mr. Whitney was a guest with Mrs. Chandler, a relative at Elgin. Mr. Orin Clifford of this city and Percy Chandler, also of this city. He has early history at his tongue's end and can relate first hand, numerous thrilling experiences of his early boyhood and young manhood when life was strenuous in the far west.
