## PHILIPINO BAND WERE HERE

FAMOUS MILITARY BAND PASSES  
THROUGH THIS MORNING.

Was Brought Especially From Manila  
to Play For Taft at Inauguration.

The Philippine band, the famous military band of Manila, P. I., which was brought especially from Manila to Washington to play at the inaugural ceremonies of President Taft, passed through La Grande this morning on the second section of No. 7. There were 84 Philipinos in the band. Three officers have charge of the company. Major A. F. Fiske, commanding officer and Major S. C. Gurney and Captain Walter Loving, subordinate officers. After the inauguration of President Taft they have been playing at the principal summer resorts of the country. They have just finished an engagement at Denver and are on their way to Seattle, where they will play at the exposition after which they will fill a three days engagement in San Francisco, when they will return to Manila. The special stayed here 15 minutes during which the members of the band went through drill exercises. They are well trained and deserve the national reputation which they bear.

The annual Oregon Presbytery will be held in this city on October 4th. They will transact the business which comes under this head after which the Synod will be held in Newberg on the following Wednesday, the 6th. Dr. Seemann will attend the Synod at Newberg and deliver two addresses. The first will be on "Calvin's Work and its Influence in Theology, Education and government," and the other on "Sunday School Work." The year of 1909 is the third centennial of the birth of John Calvin.
