Milk, by the pint and quart, has ricketed, or rather will, on October first, when local dairymen advance the price from its present basis. Notice to this effect was given out today by members of the local dairymen's personnel. After that date milk will sell by quart allotments for \$2.50 per month and \$1.35 per pint per month. The present selling price is \$1.00 and \$2.00.
The Blue Mountain Creamery has also served notice to the public of the increase, but that institution is on a different basis as will be seen in the notice in this issue.

PURE MILK CAMPAIGN

Father Pure Milk Crusade.
At the meeting of the Eastern Oregon physicians in Pendleton this week, the following resolution was adopted:
The Resolution.
Whereas, the necessity for strong, healthy childhood looking toward vigorous maturity and a nation of virile, effective men and women is cordially recognized, and
Whereas, it is conceded that milk is the most important single item of food for infants and young children, and
Whereas, it is a matter of common knowledge that many of the dairies of this state are kept in an unsanitary manner with unhealthy cows, a consequently unwholesome milk production, be it
Resolved, That the Eastern Oregon District Medical Society give its endorsement and approval to any organized effort tending toward more rigid inspection of dairies, cows and systems of milk delivery which will result in permanent increase in the quality of the milk and insure cleanliness of production, and be it further
Resolved, That this society heartily commend the campaign being waged in Portland to better the milk supply of that city and that this commendation extend to those officers, organizations, newspapers and individuals taking active part in the crusade.

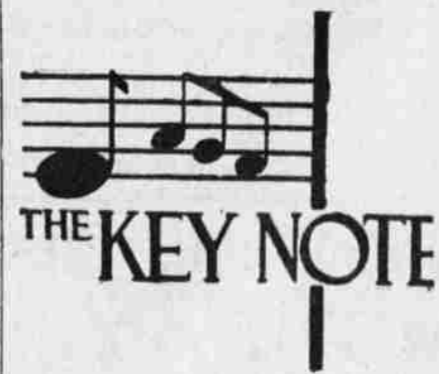
