END OF DELAY IS AT HAND

STEEL FOR BRIDGE WILL BE SHIPPED AT ONCE.

After a Long Delay the Local Contractors Will Get Material.

The steel for the Oro Dell bridge is to be hurried to La Grande, according to a letter received today by Contractors Campbell & Fitzgerald. There has been untold delay on account of pressure brought to bear by the large bridge concerns because the contract was awarded to local La Grande people, for the reason that the local people bid the lowest. This trouble has now been eradicated and the steel will be hurried here to complete the structure at once.

The cement abutments are all ready and the erection of the steel girders after they have arrived will require no great length of time.

ON For Little Salmon.

Three left here this morning for the favorite hunting grounds. They are Night Policeman John Walden, his son Claude and Jim Mulholland. They were thoroughly equipped for a considerable stay in the wilds and before they return hope to have bagged considerable large game. They will head for the Little Salmon district reached by crossing Looking Glass and proceeding about 40 miles beyond that point. Sufficient camp material was taken along to keep the nimrods comfortable and they will not return until success is theirs.

ACCIDENTALLY KILLED.

Young Man Traveling Overland Shoots Himself.

ECHO, Ore. Oct. 14.—John Halben, a young man whose parents reside in Lewiston, Idaho, accidentally shot himself at a point about three miles west of Echo, Monday afternoon and died a short time after that in the office of a local doctor. Young Halben, in the company with three others was traveling from Lewiston, Idaho to California.

It is not known exactly how the accident happened but is presumed that he was taking his gun from the wagon to shoot a jackrabbit. In some manner the firearm was discharged, the bullet piercing the right breast of the young man. His brothers brought the wounded man immediately to this place but he expired soon after reaching the office of the local physician.

SCABS ATTACK VICTIM.

Twelve Rescued From Wrecked Boat Assaulted on Landing.

DETROIT, Oct. 14.—The striking seaman today indignantly denied that they were responsible for the attack that was made by the strike sympathizers on the survivors of the steamer George Stone which was wrecked on Lake Erie.

Six men were drowned in the wreck and twelve were rescued but they had hardly set their feet on the shore before they were attacked by a howling mob. One of the survivors was knocked into the water and came nearly being drowned a second time before they were rescued by the police.

Mr. and Mrs. Judd Geer returned home from Portland today and continued their journey to Cove via Union.

Fatalities Increasing.

NEW ORLEANS, Oct. 13.—A wireless message from Key West today reports that at least a thousand of the men employed on the Florida East Coast railroad have been drowned in the hurricane which wrecked the city of Key West, Monday. Many that have been reported as having perished lived in boat houses which were moored to the trestlework of the road, all of which has been destroyed.
