#### MERCY OF COURT PRAYED FOR BY JURY.

#### Violation of Liquor Ordinance Causes Trouble For Wilkinson.

A verdict of guilty was returned last evening about 6 o'clock in the case of the city of La Grande vs. Robt. Wilkinson, charged with selling near beer to a minor, Roy Chenault, in violation of a city ordinance. In connection with the verdict the jury recommended the defendant to the extreme mercy of the court.

Wilkinson will remain free under his bonds until Monday morning when sentence will be passed upon him. It will be remembered that from the evidence in the case the near beer was sold by one of Wilkinson's employes.
