GOOD ROADS IN SIGHT

BOOTH LANE TO BE TREATED TO MACADAM.

Not Alone La Grande End but Elgin Side to have Improvements.

That the Grand Ronde Valley is soon to have a system of good roads was the statement of Bridge Superintendent J. F. Campbell who went out this morning to the rock quarry at the foot of Carbine Hill to rush the work of taking out rock for the crusher located at that place. The crusher will start next week when a sufficient supply of rock has been taken out of the quarry to keep the machines running.

The rock is now being crushed for macadamizing two miles of road in Booth lane. This work will be taken up at once and rushed to completion this fall. Superintendent Campbell said that he looked for no weather bad enough to check this work before its completion. With the superb piece of work done on the road east of the city as a sample it is thought that the county will have the backing of the people of the valley in continuing the policy of building permanent highways as rapidly as possible.

Great improvement has been made in the county roads in the vicinity of Elgin. A large number of grades have been constructed and bridges put in. A force of men have been working in that section for a month.

Will Lay Corner Stone.

Baker City, Oct. 20.—The Herald of today says: "The laying of the corner stone of the new postoffice in this city will take place Friday afternoon at the new building, corner of Dewey and Auburn. At this time several articles of greater or less value and telling of Baker City and Baker county will be placed in the receptacle to remain until the building is torn down to give way to a larger structure. It may be that a history of the movement to secure the new building will be one of the articles to be placed in the safe keeping of the corner stone.

The ceremonies attendant upon the laying of the corner stone will be very simple although it is expected that several addresses by prominent citizens will be made. Several people have worked hard to secure the new postoffice and it is only right that they should be asked to address the people on the great occasion.

Hold a Milk Contest.

Pittsburg, Oct. 21.—Nearly all of the dairymen supplying milk to Pittsburg have entered exhibits in a contest held today by the Chamber of Commerce, which offers prizes for the purest milk and cream and the cleanest dairy farm.

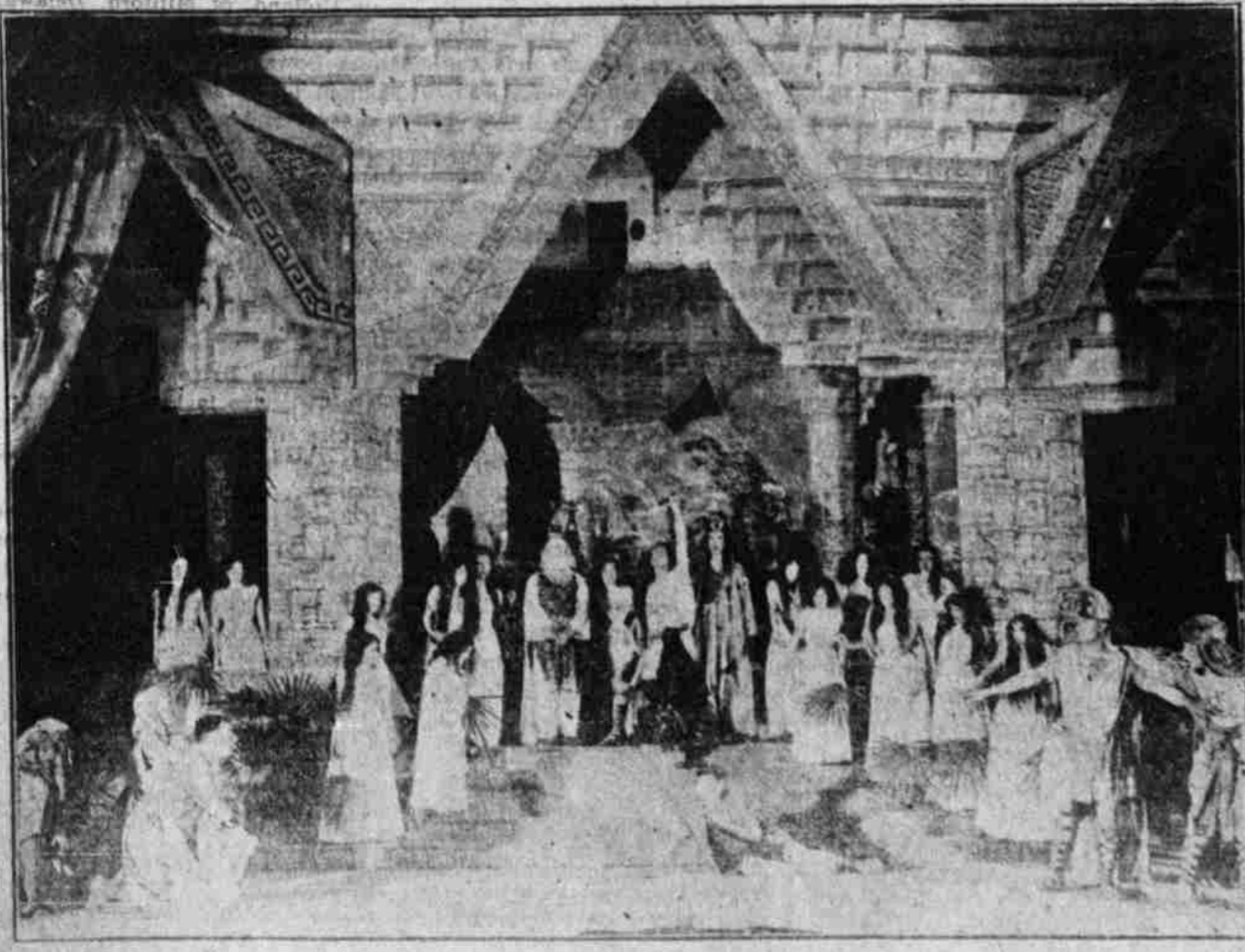
