Campbell who went out this morning to the rock quarry at the foot of Carbine Hill to rush the work of taking out rock for the glasses if they are necessary. crusher located at that place. The crusher will start next week when a sufficient supply of rock has been taken out of the quarry to keep the machines running.

The rock is now being crushed for Booth lane. This work will be taken up at once and rushed to completion this fall. Superintendent Campbell said that he looked for no weather bad enough to check this work before its completion.
