MUCH PRESTIGE IN CONTEST

SATURDAY'S CONTEST PLACED LA GRANDE IN FOREFRONT

Next Saturday's Game Here Has Huge Bearing on Championship.

With one of La Grande's big football games out of the way, Coach Wall is this week turning his attention to next Saturday when the local football lovers will see another game of considerable importance. Pendleton's Academy team will be here on that date to attempt, if possible to wrest the Eastern Oregon Championship from the team that is now on the road to that goal with rapid strides.

Coach Wall and his players have a more important standing and a far greater prestige in football and athletic circles in general throughout the Northwest, today than last Saturday. The spectacular showing made against Spokane has been heralded abroad, and, too more especially, the remarkable use which the team made of the forward pass throughout the game. Such things as these have made the Northwest sit up and take notice to La Grande, and to those who think it a waste of time to play the more pretentious teams, let them read the press comment concerning the game in all of the leading papers of the Northwest.

While the game next Saturday will not be of interstate importance, it will have a distinct bearing on the championship of Eastern Oregon, and the local team will have to be on its pins always to meet and defeat the academy squad.

NEW ENGINES COMING.

Two More Big Ten-Wheelers For Local Service Expected at Once.

Two ten wheelers, Numbers 215 and 216, are expected to arrive for local service on the mountain division at almost any time. The engines are of the most improved type. Two other engines are coming in the same shipment, namely Number 31 and 32, for switch engine purposes on the west end. They are oil burners.

ENLARGE LOCAL OFFICE.

Pacific States Telephone Company to Make Extensive Improvements.

W. S. Bell of San Francisco arrived last night to take charge of the improvements and enlargement of the local office of the Pacific States Telephone company. Mr. Bell came from Pendleton yesterday where he has been doing a bit of less extensive improvement work than is contemplated in this city.

While the plans and specifications for the work have not yet arrived it is understood that the work to be done here includes putting in a new multiple switch board which will make a much larger and swifter service possible. Until the specifications arrive the number of men to be employed can not be ascertained but it is supposed that the work will require about six skilled electricians.

Direct Primary Law.

East St. Louis, Ill., Oct. 25.—Gov. Deneen today took advantage of the dedication of the Federal Building here and the Tate celebration in the big city across the river to begin a campaign for a direct primary law. The Governor will stump the state in advocacy of such a law, in the hope that popular demand will force the legislature in special session next December to enact it.

His tour will probably cover the State, and especially those districts whose members are considered opposed to the direct primary law or who are thought to be a little weak-kneed will be visited and given consideration.

The Governor expressed a hope that all personalities would be avoided, but made it plain that if necessary he would speak out in no uncertain terms. The waterway plans of the administration will be fully explained but primary legislation will hold the center of the stage.

Governor Deneen has been greatly encouraged by present developments. The change in sentiment in favor of direct primary bill has been noticeable nowhere more than in the executive offices.
