It would have been an act in which there would have been popular participation-something we might reasonably expect, where one popular government said to the other. "I'm glad to shake you by the hand." and the other popular government replied in kind. What the Presidents said to each other, either on the first or the second call, is not known and in ill pro-- babilities would not appeal to us if it were known. They might have said: "It is a fine day," or "the pleasure is all mine," or indulged in any one or any number of the common platitudes which the atmosphere of formal courtesy which prevailed suggested. But speculation as to what was said is thrust into the background by the trimmings of the occasion, which were copied from barbarism. 


