NEW LINE UNDER WAY

That the Umatilla Railway & Electric Company will develop an electric power on the John Day river and build an electric line from Dale to Pendleton and from this place to the Columbia, provided that proper support is given the enterprise, is now announced by the officers of that company. A statement to this effect was made to the East Oregonian today by Douglas Belts, president; George Arthur Brown, vice-president, and A. R. Turner, secretary of the company, says the Pendleton E. O.

At this time all three gentlemen are in the city consulting with the business men and others regarding the project. It is planned to have a meeting of the managers of the Commercial association shortly and at that time the detailed plans of the company will be made known.

The Umatilla Railway and Electric Company has a power site on the north bank of the John Day and its offices have been working for a year or more upon the plans for developing that and building an electric road to the Columbia. John T. Whistler, the well known engineer who built the Umatilla Irrigation project and General Stubblefield who was formerly with the reclamation service, are serving as the engineers for the company. They have made a hydrographic survey and also a preliminary survey for the electric road. It is understood that from an engineering standpoint the road is very feasible.

A right of way for the road from the south end of the county to Pendleton has also been secured. As announced by the officers of the company, the road will go down the north bank of the John Day river a few miles to Camas creek, thence lead up Camas creek to Camas prairie, lead northward along the western side of Camas prairie to Willow Springs, thence down the ridge to Pilot Rock, down Birch creek to the East side for distance of five miles, thence across to McKay creek and to the Tutuilla, down the Tutuilla to Pendleton, entering the city at the foot of Webb street. From Pendleton the course of the road is down the river for a few miles and thence across to Cold Springs landing.
