## IMPORTANT TO FARMERS

O. A. C. SENDING OUT VALUABLE  
BOOKLETS.

"Business Side of Farming," Just of  
The Colgel Press.

The "Business Side of Farming," is the title of a recent publication from the Oregon Agricultural College press. The bulletin is part I of the general subject and is devoted to farm records. It is written in a clear, simple style and will be easily comprehended by any farmer. It is handsomely illustrated by 20 full page engravings. Future bulletins on rural law and rural economy are promised. Like all the college and station bulletins, it is published for free distribution.

It is gratifying to note that the state college is taking the lead in this important subject. No phase of agricultural education is more important or more generally neglected. The short comings of the American farmer in this respect has been revealed repeatedly. President Roosevelt on the Rural Commission have remarked, on more than one occasion, that this is one of the defects of rural education. The lack of correct business methods have not only ruined countless farmers but it often drives the boys off the farm. The present census is emphasizing statistics on farm finance more than usually, but it is feared that but little information that is absolutely reliable will be given.

Professor Bexell, the author of the bulletin, says in his introduction: "It is a truism to say that the financial side of farming is of the utmost importance. But the fact remains that this side of the world's greatest industry is almost entirely neglected by both the farmer and the schools. Professor Baily says on this subject: 'In visiting practically every farm in one of the counties of New York we did not find one man who knew how much it cost him to produce milk or to raise any of his crops.'"
