## DECIDE ON EXHIBITS

ONE OF THE IMPORTANT MATTERS TO BE DECIDED.

Apple Show Has Vast Importance in Apple World.

One of the important business matters to come up at the meeting of the Commercial club directors tonight is the arrangement for La Grande's part in having a county exhibit at the National apple show in Spokane when that event opens on November 15.

While the primary purpose of the apple show is to establish a standard to assist growers in the culture and marketing of the fruit and to create and to supply the increasing demand for the apple, it is designed also to bring together the growers and the men who handle the products of orchards in a commercial way, with a view toward greater development of the industry.

Another object is to demonstrate to the people of the west the possibilities of intelligent intensive cultivation and to show the East and North and South the value to the whole country of this development.

Professor H. E. Van Denman of Washington D. C., head of the board of judges, will be assisted by H. M. Dunlap of Savoy, Ill., presiding judge of the first show last year; Professor W. J. Green chief horticulturist of the Ohio Agricultural college experiment station; George J. Kellogg of Lake Mills, Wis. and A. Mosler of Mosier, Ore., and many others, all active in the commercial points of apple culture. They will make their awards under a liberal interpretation of the scoring rules and regulations of the American Pomological society.

The management has arranged a premium list, offering \$25,000 in prizes, including the sweepstakes of \$1500 in the carload class, which carries with it the title of apple king of America, for exhibits ranging from a full car of 630 boxes or 210 barrels to a single plate of apples in 20 classes, with the conditions governing various exhibits sufficiently wide to make the competition international in character.

There will be more than 2,000,000 apples, including standard varieties from the foremost commercial orchard districts of the entire country. It is truly worth while for Union county and La Grande to take an active part in this apple show.

Will Not Admit that He stole From Great Northern Express Office.

Seattle, Oct. 29.—Although almost constantly under the sweating of the Seattle police, Charles D. Howell, the railroad watchman who is a prisoner in the county jail under the charge of having held up the Great Northern Express Office on the night of October 10

and relieved the night agent of about \$12,000, persists in declaring his innocence.

The police claim that they have secured sufficient evidence to convict Howell, who steadfastly maintains his innocence. They say that Howell, who has been in jail since the 20th began to spend money lavishly the day following the robbery, whereas he previously eked out a bare living.
