NEW ATHLETIC FIELD FOR THE O. A. C. ATHLETES.

Walter M. Pierce Home From Corvallis Where he Met Regents.

The purchase of a new heating plant or all the buildings connected with the Oregon Agricultural College, the purchase of seven acres of land for a new athletic field and buildings at a cost of \$20,000 and the consideration of business connected with the completion of the new \$35,000 armory, were some of the more important transactions of the board of regents of the state school held this week in Portland according to Regent Walter M. Pierce who returned this morning.

The old athletic field is to be occupied by buildings and the great games will hereafter be played on the new field just back of and adjoining the old field. The new armory, according to Mr. Pierce, is to be one of the finest in the United States.
