To Make Cumberland Navigable.
Nashville, Tenn., Nov. 12.—To make the Cumberland navigable is the purpose of the Cumberland River Improvement Association, which began a session here today.

The purpose of this association in this instance will be to launch a movement for the improving of the condition of the Cumberland river and to attract attention to and create a sentiment in favor of carrying on the work which has been started and whatever else might add to or make better the traffic and transportation on the Cumberland. An effort will also be made to devise ways and means by which the United States government can be induced to push to early completion the work it has begun and to make the necessary appropriation for more extensive improvements on the Cumberland.

There has already been sufficient money appropriated to complete the work now under way on the lower river, and it is being carried forward as rapidly as possible, but the upper river improvement was started and it was found that there was not sufficient money with which to complete it, so the work is at a standstill. The association will very likely take this matter up and endeavor to bring influence to bear that will cause the work on the upper Cumberland to be renewed and completed as early as possible.

Taft in Connecticut.

Middletown Conn., Nov. 12.—In the presence of a distinguished audience which included President Wm. H. Taft Dr. Wm. A. Shanklin was today inaugurated as president of Wesleyan University. From this city Mr. Taft goes to Hartford, where the new state arsenal and armory is to be dedicated. Wesleyan University was opened in 1831 by the New York and New England conferences of the Methodist Episcopal church, and is the leading educational institutions of that denomination in the country. Since 1862 the university has been co-educational.

Eleven Year-Old Pianist.
New York, Nov. 12.—Popito Arriola, the international famous boy pianist, who is now only eleven years of age, will make his American debut at Carnegie Hall this afternoon. In February he goes to the Pacific coast to fill the canceled Rosenthal engagement.
