DIVORCES ARE GRANTED

MC CUMBER CASE TAKEN UNDER ACTION TEMPORARILY.

Two From Elgin and one From Hot Lake Given Divorces.

Yesterday was divorce day for Judge Knowles. After hearing the Mires case from Hot Lake and granting the relief sought in the morning the McCumber suit came up in the afternoon on arguments and motions preliminary to the trial. Mrs. McCumber was granted \$50 for attorney's fees, \$35 to guarantee the expenses of defending her case and \$20 per month temporary alimony until the case can be tried out upon its merits.

Other segregation suits to be heard were Gaddis vs Gaddis and Munroe vs. Munroe. Both of these cases were from Elgin. The witnesses in each returned home this morning. Neither of the suits were contested.

LOSES FINGERS IN SAWMILL

FINGERS SUFFER HEAVILY IN A SAWMILL ACCIDENT.

One Man at Perry and One Here Quite Seriously Injured.

Two men were injured today by the machinery in sawmills, one being at the George Palmer Lumber Company mills and the other at the Perry mills. At the first named mill, George Willis suffered injuries when his hand came in contact with a rip saw. His thumb, index and middle fingers were severed. Doctor Molitor treated the wounds at the hospital and hopes to save the hand.

Peter Healy was hurt at Perry when his hand was caught in the edger. The index and middle fingers were crushed but may be saved.

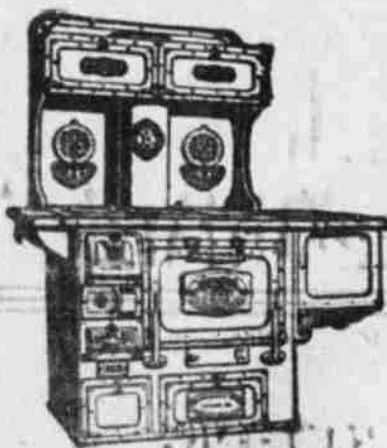
