

WATER USERS TO MEET ON DEC. 11TH

TO DITCH CONSTRUCTION.

Directors Yesterday Afternoon Consider Plan to get Water Users to Study Present Contracts.

At a meeting of the Grande Ronde Reservoir Company held yesterday afternoon, December 11 was set as the date of the general meeting to be held in this city for the purpose of meeting the stockholders and the water users to submit the situation fully to them and to discuss the contracts in all their detail.

The details of the engineer's work on the project will then be practically wound up. All rights of way have been secured and the enterprise will be formally and actively launched. After the terms of the contracts under which the water is to be used have been thoroughly established and understood by the water users, the greatest enterprise in the history of Union county will be ready for active construction.

The promoters of the assembly have not got very far, but they have already struck some big snags that will keep them busy, and if they want any more evidence that the assembly plan is doomed to defeat they can get it in short order.—Salem Journal.

Dec. 1.—Gus Sartin who is wanted in Fayetteville, Arkansas, charged with having brutally murdered an elderly lady in order to rob her of her life savings, and in Sherman Texas for the murder of a dummer and the theft of his trunks containing over \$5,000 worth of diamonds, hanged himself in his cell early today. In order to make sure of the job he sawed his wrist open with a piece of steel, severing an artery.

PERRY CUT IS OVER HALF FINISHED

SEVERAL NEW SIDINGS HAVE ALREADY BEEN COMPLETED.

Telocaset Among those That Have Been Equipped with New Tracks.

Rapid progress is being made by Twohey Bros., contractors, on the extensive side track work being done along the O. R. & N. in Eastern Oregon. The big cut at Perry where the county road is to be changed, is now over half completed, according to the men in charge of the work, and as indications point to excellent weather, from now on, the work will be able to proceed unhampered. The Perry job is more extensive than any of the others.

Several sidings have been completed. The new passing track at Telocaset is finished, the Huron siding done and the siding at mile post 2176, between Huron and Meacham is also finished. These are of course contracts that have been completed since the Hillgard and Wilcox mill sidings were finished. Twohey Bros., still maintain their head office in this city.
