NEW DOCTOR IN LOCAL DIRECTORY

Will Stay While Dr. Richardson Takes Post Graduate Course in East.

Dr. H. L. Underwood of New York is in the city and is thinking of locating permanently. At any rate he will make this his headquarters until the return of Dr. and Mrs. A. L. Richardson from the East, about five months hence. MAY RETRY LONG CASE

District Attorney Ivanhoe and his assistants have prepared and forwarded to the supreme court a 17-page petition asking for a re-hearing of the famous escheat case of the State of Oregon vs. McDonald. The petition states three grounds for a re-hearing, (1) on the right of a non-relative to testify to a question of relationship; (2) the statements of an administrator regarding the traditions and family history of the intestate, and (3) the right of the circuit court to deal with a question of the escheat of personal property.

BAD BLAZE AT TACOMA

Tacoma, Dec. 1.—A fire which is supposed to have been caused by incendiary, this morning completely destroyed the immense warehouse of the John B. Stevenson Company, containing an immense supply of hay, grain, and staple groceries. The loss is estimated at \$150,000.

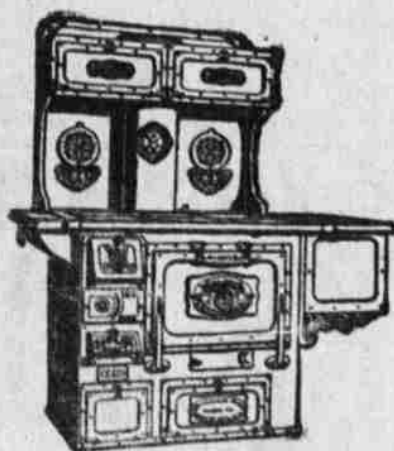
