## DUTCH WILL LEAVE SOON

**BREAK HEADQUARTERS LATTER PART OF WEEK.**

**Pickler's Report Accepted by Council Plant is Well Built.**

By the end of the present week, W. A. Dutch, local superintendent of construction of projects for the American Light & Power Company will abandon his headquarters here and leave for his home in Indianapolis. Mr. Dutch has been here continuously since the middle of August, the project having been approximately completed in three months. His presence here has meant much to the merchants for provisions as far as possible, were all purchased in La Grande in accordance with the contract stipulating such action.

The report of Engineer Pickler which was mentioned in last evening's Observer, was read at the special council meeting last night and accepted. Mr. Pickler's work is completed, and while payments due the company have been made, there are still existing some bonds which will be annulled in the near future. As the report of the engineer states, the system has proven itself substantial, notwithstanding that the pressure is enormous and flaws likely to exist. By lending close scrutiny to the work from the beginning to the end, and by reason of the fact that the pipeline was thoroughly tested under the supervision of the engineer as each link of the line was laid in place. It was no revelation to the constructors that the pipe line stood the pressure when the stop valve was opened. Mr. Pickler in conjunction with the city at large, feels that there is every reason to be elated over the apparent success of the project. La Grande now has water that will "make Bull Run some."

### LINE NEARS LA GRANDE.

But for a few days intervention of bad weather, the new copper circuit between La Grande and Joseph being built by the Home Independent Telephone Company, would be completed by Christmas. As it is, it will require a few days' additional time. The line is now headed out of Elgin for La Grande.
