## BRING BODY TO THIS CITY

REMAINS OF C. R. THORNTON NOW IN LA GRANDE.

Architect of No Mean Ability and Resident of this City for Years.

Escorted by representatives of the W. O. W. of which the deceased was a member, the remains of Calvin R. Thornton were taken to the R. W. Leighton home this afternoon to await interment. The body was escorted from Enterprise, where the demise occurred yesterday, to La Grande by relatives and friends of the late architect.

Mr. Thornton was born in Iowa in 1861 and lived there until grown when he moved to Weiser, Idaho, and stayed there one summer and then moved to this city where he has made his home until this fall when he moved to Enterprise for the winter. He leaves besides his wife and an adopted son 11 years old, his mother and father, Mr. and Mrs. Joshua Thornton, of Earlham, Iowa, two brothers, Isaac of Nevada, Mo. and James of Earlham, Iowa, two sisters Ella and Melissa also of Earlham.

The funeral arrangements have as yet not been definitely arranged, but it is thought that they will be held from the Methodist Episcopal church Sunday morning at ten forty five, interment following in the Odd Fellows cemetery. The remains were brought in this afternoon on the Watlows train and were taken to the home of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Leighton, 1802 Cedar avenue.
