NEW SCHOOL HAS PROBLEM

EVIDENT COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL PLAN IS TO BE DROPPED.

From Many Standpoints Such an Institution is Not Desirable.

New high school movements having had their inception a few days since, are now awaiting a meeting of the Commercial Club board when the policy of the board will be ascertained relative as to whether or not the school building, which must be built, shall be along county high school lines or a strictly city and district proposition. While of course, nothing has been done to determine the official policy of the board which is to be behind the movement, likely, it seems evident that the county school proposition will be overrun with objections, and the city school substituted. There was a time in the recent past when a county high school was logical, but it seems under the new law that a county building will simply be a bone of contention between the various districts of the valley. As many schools as the taxpayers will stand for, can be secured under the new law. It is an admitted fact that as soon as one district secures a county high school, others will apply for a similar institution.

The petition asking for a \$75,000 building is practically ready for signatures but the prevailing feeling now among the big taxpayers on the question alluded to, will be learned before the final action of completing the petition is taken. That La Grande needs a new high school badly and must have it, is a foregone conclusion—a fact that has been a reality long enough and is becoming more formidable every day. The coming week will no doubt see the movement culminate in a largely signed petition being filed with the school clerk, in which event a special school election must be voted on soon.
