MORE MACADANIZING.

Two Important Thoroughfares to be Dressed With Surfacing in near Future.

Appended are two important notices of street improving, calling for the macadamizing of two heavily traveled streets in the city. The work is to be carried on under the direction of the improvement district laws and will serve to give La Grande hard surfaced streets quicker than any other plan possibly could. The two official notices follow:

Resolution creating Improvement District No. 12.

Be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, that Pennsylvania avenue from Washington avenue to the City limits be and the same is hereby declared to be and designated as improvement district No. 12.

Be it further resolved that A. V. Andrews, J. J. Reynolds and E. W. Kammerer, members of the council be, and they are hereby appointed by the council commissioners who shall make an examination of all property in said district, upon which assessments are to be levied for the payment of the improvement of the same, as to the valuation and extent if any, of the benefits to be derived by said property by reason of said improvements, and make report of their findings in writing to the council.

Be it further resolved that Pennsylvania avenue be and the council hereby declares its intention to have the same improved by macadamizing the same from Washington avenue to Fourth street.

It is further resolved that this resolution be published in one issue of the La Grande Evening Observer.

Resolution creating Improvement District No. 13.

Be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, that North Fir street from its intersection with Monroe avenue to the city limits be and the same is hereby created and designated as improvement district No. 13.

And J. T. Williamson, J. K. Sheak and George Kreiger members of the council are hereby appointed by the council as commissioners who shall make an examination of all the property in said district hereinafter described upon which assessments are to be levied to pay for the improvements to be made thereon, to wit: from Monroe avenue to "V" avenue, as to the valuation and extent, if any, of the benefits to be derived by reason of said improvements, and report their findings in writing to the council.

It is further resolved that portion of said district from Monroe avenue to V avenue be, and the council hereby declares its intention to have the same improved by macadamizing the same.

It is further resolved that this resolution be published in one issue of

the La Grande Evening Observer.

HEARING CONTINUED AGAIN.

Evidence in Lombard Case Is Mostly Hearsay and the Case Has Been Continued.

The evidence was mostly hearsay and few of the witnesses called Saturday night could testify that they had seen Mr. Lombard severely punish the children.

Neighbors say that they have heard children screaming from what they supposed was heavy punishment that was being inflicted by the stepfather, but few, if any had actually seen him actually administer the chastisements.

As soon as Mrs. Lombard is able to come to La Grande the case will be completed. The children were left in Lombard's care.
