# SHORTEST DAY IN 1909

WINTER SOLSTICE COMMENCED THIS MORNING

In a Day or Two the Days Will begin to Lengthen again.

December 22, the shortest day of 1909 passed with indications of coming sleighing. With the ground frozen hard and well leveled, a small amount of snow will insure excellent sleighing.

December 22 marks the period known to astronomers as the Winter solstice, a period lasting about two days when the sun has reached a point directly over the tropic of Capricorn and seemingly for the time is neither varying nor or south in its annual inclination north and south. In a day or two the sun will vary towards the north again, lengthening the days and finally on March 21 will have reached the equator when the day and night will be of equal length, and on June 22nd reach the Summer Solstice or the longest day in the year in the Northern hemisphere.
